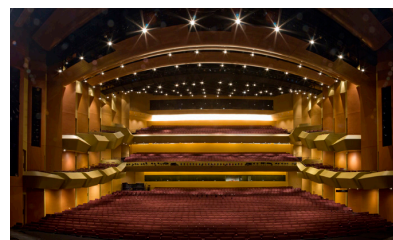

THE KENTUCKY CENTER WHITNEY HALL

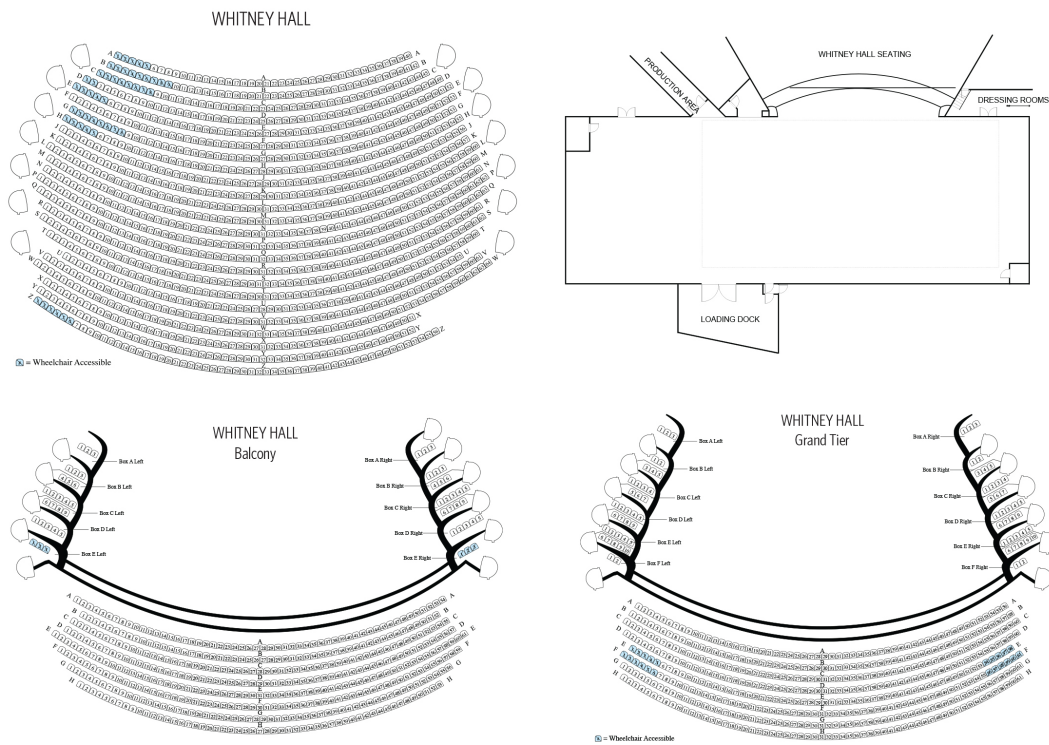
